Study predicts fall in crop yields

CLIMATE | A study conducted by the Financial and Fiscal Commission into the effects of climate change on vulnerable households in the Eastern Cape and Limpopo found that average crop yields were expected to decline in the Eastern Cape between 8.2% and 15% in the early part of this century and by between 6.4% and 14.3% mid-century.
